**CALLED TO BE A SECULAR FRANCISCAN:** In 1205, Francis of Assisi was called by God to rebuild the Church. Early in his ministry Francis recognized the need to include people from all walks of life within his movement of reform and renewal. The work of following Christ in humility, joy and love, which is the vocation of all Christians, could not be restricted to traditional religious life of the Friars and the Sisters. This was true in the 13<sup>th</sup> century and remains so today. Today there are estimated to be over a half-million Franciscans world wide in the various denominations of the Christian family.
