MESSAGE FROM FATHER LANE: As many of you know, I will be turning 70 years old this year. To put the timeline in perspective, I was born the week after Germany invaded Poland in September of 1939. The week I was born, England, France and Canada responded by declaring war on the Third Reich and the Second World War began. For most of you that was a very long time ago - actually for me too it was a very long time ago!

In the Diocese of Columbus, each priest must offer their resignation/retirement from administrative duties at age 70. I have complied with that regulation and Bishop Campbell has accepted. I will be retired on July 14th of this year, the normal time for parish changes in Columbus. While July 14th will be two months early for me, it will allow St. Margaret's to participate more fully in the diocesan-wide selection process for a new pastor.

I will address this issue with you more completely later, but I wanted to let you know officially now instead of letting the news come only via the grapevine - and the grapevine is humming throughout the diocese. This has been a wonderful seven years for me and I am deeply grateful to all of you. I hope these years have been good for you as well. We will pray for the parish and trust that God continues to look over all of us.

2009 LENTEN SCHEDULE

On days of abstinence, flesh meat is not to be eaten. This law applies to those who are 14 years and older.

On days of fast, one full meal is allowed, along with two lesser meals the same day. This law of fast applies to those between the ages of 18 and 59.
