**ITALY IN NOVEMBER:** Bishop Ready High School, as part of its upcoming (2010-11) 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, is sponsoring an 11-day trip to Italy in November. The trip is open to alums, parents, grandparents, and friends of Bishop Ready High School; students will be permitted to go only if accompanied by an adult. Father Pat Toner, pastor of St. Joseph/Plain City, will accompany the group as chaplain.
