THE THIRD REICH AND THE CHURCH: On Wednesday Evening, April 29th, at 7PM there will be a lecture in the church by Dr. Jeffrey Lewis, a senior Lecturer at Ohio State. Dr. Lewis is a member of St. Margaret's and is an expert on Nazi Germany and modern Terrorism. We know that the Church has been implicated in many moral failures concerning the rise of Germany in the 1930's and know also that, since about 1963 and Rudolph Hochhuth's play *The Deputy*, Pope Pius XII has been seen as having failed in his responsibilities to the people of Europe. More and more literature is coming out that analyzes the role the Church and the Pope played in the events of the Second World War. This is a wonderful opportunity to hear the arguments and be introduced to the literature.
