If you are ill or are just getting over the flu or a cold, please refrain from shaking hands at the Sign of Peace. A simple bow or smile to your neighbor in the pew will suffice. Also if someone does not wish to shake hands with you, please do not feel offended. These practices are only temporary until circumstances improve. Thank you for understanding.
