ASH WEDNESDAY: Lent begins this week with **Ash Wednesday** on **February 17**. Ashes will be distributed at the Masses that day at **9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.** This is a great way to begin Lent.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are both days of **FAST** for Catholics ages 18-59 inclusively. On fast days, one full meal and two lesser meals are permitted. Only liquids are allowed between meals.

ASH WEDNESDAY, GOOD FRIDAY AND ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT are days of **ABSTINENCE** from meat for all persons 14 years of age and older. We are asked to abstain from meat on these days in penitential self denial and in solidarity with, and in service to, the hungry of the world.

ASH WEDNESDAY COLLECTION: The proceeds of Ash Wednesday collection will be contributed to the Joint Organization for Inner-city Needs (J.O.I.N.). J.O.I.N. is a diocesan agency that provides emergency assistance to the poor in the form of food, food certificates, clothing, prescription assistance, utility help, infant formula, eyeglasses, bus transportation, birth certificates, ensure for seniors, car repair, burial assistance and referrals to other public and private service providers. **Please be Generous.**

OPERATION RICE BOWL: This Lent, our community is participating in **Operation Rice Bowl**, a Lenten program for Catholic Relief Services. Proceeds raised will help our less fortunate brothers and sisters in our diocese and around the world. You are asked to fast or eat a reduced meal once a week and place the savings from your meal in your rice bowl. A bowl for this collection will be at the entrance of the church. **Please take one home for your use and return it at the end of Lent.**
