CONFESSIONS DURING LENT: This Lent, we will **NOT** have the Sacrament of Confession (Reconciliation) on Thursday evenings. Instead we will have a **Communal Lenten Penance Service here at St. Margaret on TUESDAY, MARCH 9, 7:00 p.m.** in the church.

LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE: This **Tuesday, March 9th**, will be our Communal Lenten Penance Service at 7:00 p.m. in our church. We will have a brief Liturgy of The Word and then we will have 5 priests available for Confessions. This is a great way to enter into the true spirit of Lent. Come join us!!

VESPERS & STATIONS OF THE CROSS: On **Thursdays of Lent (except for Holy Thursday)** we will be having Vespers or the Evening Prayer of the Church at 7:30 p.m. followed immediately by the Stations of the Cross. These are both excellent prayers of our Church to be prayed during the Holy season of Lent.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER TRAINING: There will be a training session for ALL Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Ministers) following the **11:30 Mass on Sunday, March 21.** All current Ministers and those who wish to serve as new Ministers are required to attend. EUCHARIST ADORATION AT ST. MARGARET: We do have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament here **EVERY** Thursday from **Mass at 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m.** This is a great opportunity, especially during Lent, to spend some quiet time with our Lord in the Eucharist. What an awesome privilege this is! We have the sign-up sheet in the vestibule. We are now asking for people to sign up for **1-Hour Time Slots**. Also we are trying to have a minimum of **TWO PEOPLE** signed up for every time. For once the Eucharist is exposed it may never be left alone until the Eucharist is reposed once again. An hour is not a long time once a week. As is stated in the **Agony of the Garden** in the **Gospel of Mark 14:37, "When Jesus returned he found them asleep. He said to Peter: 'Simon are you asleep? Could you not keep watch for one hour?'"**
