LENTEN REGULATIONS

GOOD FRIDAY is a day of **FAST** for Catholics ages 18-59 inclusively. On fast days, one full meal and two lesser meals are permitted. Only liquids are allowed between meals.

ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT are days of **ABSTINENCE** from meat for all persons 14 years of age and older. We are asked to abstain from meat on these days in penitential self denial and in solidarity with, and in service to, the hungry of the world.
