SCHOOL NEWS

H2O FOR LIFE & TRINITY CATHOLIC SCHOOL, BRINGING WATER TO THE WORLD...ONE SCHOOL AT A TIME: It all started with a 6th grade science project at Trinity School by Nicole Naporano. The school had a leaking water fountain and Nicole had just learned about school children in Africa that could not attend their school because they did not have enough water. She did some research and with the help of her parents, Mr. Jeff Grimmet, Trinity's School principal, **The Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, St. Paul Province** and a nonprofit organization call H2O for Life (help to others for life) have adopted a Catholic School in Kenya Africa and committed to help fund a rain water catchment filtration system.

Every day, children in Kenya make a three hour journey to gather water! There is a water crisis throughout the world that is creating economic, social, educational and, worst of all, life threatening conditions. Children do not have the water resources they need to attend school. We can help change that statistic for one school in the world. By providing water, toilets and hand washing opportunities to the students at Alava Primary School in Kenya, general health of students improves, and girls stay in school (most girls do not attend school regularly once they reach puberty due to lack of bathrooms and water). We have the opportunity to provide a transformational service-learning opportunity for our students at Trinity School and to our community, through H2O for Life, a 501c3 non-profit organization. H2O for Life provides a global partner school connection for us. Our Trinity students will study the issues surrounding the water crisis, learn about their partner school community and country, and will plan and implement an activity to raise funds to help bring water and sanitation to our partner school. Trinity school is hoping to raise \$1000.00 this first year and hope to continue to raise funds over the next couple years. 100% of what is raised will go directly to our school partner project. We want our students to know that by working together, we can make a difference in the world. School children need clean drinking water, sanitation facilities and hygiene education to be able to learn. We hope that all students in our school will benefit from our partnership with H2O for Life. Students will be challenged to think about their own habits concerning water usage, and will develop awareness of the enormity of the issues surrounding water in our world. We hope our school will be committed to make this project for a reality. Nicole will be selling H2O for Life t-shirts after Masses at the end of May for \$10.00 each.
