### **Ask-a-Seminarian**

This is also as an answer to a question submitted "What does the church teach on birth control and about contraceptives?". I pray that the information from the Bishops will prove valuable and worthwhile for all the families of the parish. I encourage you to review it playfully, with an open heart and open mind.

Now on to more questions!

**When you pray to God does he always here you? Because if a lot of people are praying to Him at the same time, how can He hear all of them? -Rachel**

Well Rachel that is a very good question. We first must remember that God; The Most Blessed Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, is three distinct Persons but one Divine Nature, one God. God is.
